After a guest checks out, we perform a complete final clean and fully disinfect the room.



All items are disinfected after each use. In addition to intensive cleaning, extra care is given to all touch points. Among other fixtures, this refers to the light switches, door handles, remote controls, key cards, elevator buttons, taps and toilets.





A sufficient quantity of sanitising stations are available to both guests and employees throughout the entire hotel.





Dear guest,

To ensure a safe and relaxed time together, from 4 March 2022, the following rule applies: **3G**

Fully vaccinated, recovered, or tested (geimpft, genesen oder getestet)  
(negative certified quick-test prior to arrival: within the past 24 hours).

#### NOTES

##### **Digital burden of proof upon arrival**

Vaccinated and recovered individuals are only required to provide proof of their status once, upon arrival, for their entire stay in the hotel. All other guests must provide proof of a negative test upon arrival, and then every 72 hours.

##### **All guests must bring the following with them:**

- a medical-grade mask or FFFP2 mask
- an original copy of an official identification document

##### **Vaccination & recovery status**

Those who have been vaccinated once **with the Johnson and Johnson vaccination are no longer considered fully immunised (complete vaccine protection).**

**From 26 January, for a period of three months after full immunisation (2nd vaccination) or after contracting the infection,** freshly vaccinated and recovered persons are considered on a par with people who have received the booster vaccination. This also applies for persons who have received a second dose of a different vaccine, having initially received a Johnson and Johnson vaccine. **As such, there is no test obligation for the aforementioned persons.**

- Vaccinated persons must, however, wait for 14 days after vaccination. The booster vaccination is valid from the 1st day.
- Recovered persons must wait for 28 days from their positive PCR test.
- According to the new statutory regulations, this also applies if the infection occurred having received the first two vaccinations.


